

Subject: Hostel Merit List for Second Year (LEET) Students (Session 2026-27)

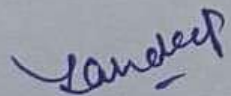
The hostel merit list for Second Year (LEET) students has been prepared on the basis of the distance criterion.

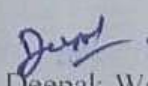

1. Students residing within 60 km of the Institute through a direct travel route will ordinarily not be considered for hostel accommodation. However, students whose journey requires changing buses two or more times, or who face significant commuting difficulties despite being within 60 km, may be considered for hostel accommodation on a case-by-case basis, subject to verification and the availability of seats.
2. All students must maintain discipline in the hostel and behave respectfully with all hostel staff. Any act of indiscipline or misconduct may lead to cancellation of hostel admission at any stage.
3. If the distance mentioned in this merit list is found to be incorrect or false, the hostel admission of the concerned student shall be cancelled immediately.
